ALL HOT WORK PERMIT ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A TWO (2) HOUR FIRE WATCH AFTER THE COMPLETION OF WORK FOR THE DAY. TWO (2) 20LB. ABC FIRE EXTINGUISHERS MUST BE LOCATED IN AREA OF HOT WORK BEING DONE.

BONFIRE PERMIT APPLICATION

A Bonfire shall only be permitted when the following conditions are met:

The Fire Marshal shall inspect the site prior to the event. A Bonfire shall not be more than five (5) feet in any dimension. Bonfires shall not burn longer than 1 hour and shall not be within one hundred (100) feet of a structure, other combustible material or property line. There shall be no overhead exposures.

Fuel for the Bonfire shall consist only of seasoned dry firewood and shall be ignited with a small quantity of paper. Wooden pallets, construction debris and other similar types of combustible materials shall not be permitted. The Bonfire shall not be used for waste disposal purposes and the fuel shall be chosen to minimize the generation of air contaminants.

All permits shall be issued to the Owner of the land upon which the Bonfire is to be kindled. APPLICATIONS FOR PERMIT SHALL BE RECEIVED BY THE FIRE MARSHAL NO LATER THAN ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE DATE REQUESTED

Fire department personnel shall standby at all Bonfires until the fire is extinguished. In the event the fire department is unavailable to standby, said display shall be CANCELED. Fire extinguishing equipment (CHARGED HOSE LINE) shall be available for immediate use. The Fire Marshal shall order the extinguishment of any Bonfire, which creates or adds to a hazardous or objectionable situation.

Issued permits shall be posted at all times and shall be readily available for inspection Permits are subject to revocation for non-compliance with the code.
