A PROCLAMATION CELEBRATING NATIONAL HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

WHEREAS, the Borough of Conshohocken wishes to celebrate and recognize the extraordinary contributions Hispanics have made to American society and culture; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 1988, on the approval of Public Law 100-402, the United States Congress set forth a series of annual Presidential Proclamations designating the "31-day period beginning September 15 and ending on October 15" as National Hispanic Heritage Month; and

WHEREAS, we celebrate all Hispanics, defined by the United States Census Bureau as "a person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South of Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin regardless of race" and further states that Hispanics or Latinos can be of any race, ancestry or ethnicity; and

WHEREAS, on this date, we recognize all Hispanics and bring awareness of culture, language, history, art, education and other highlighted moments. We adopt every year the third Friday of September as the Hispanic Day of Celebration; and

NOW THEREFORE, we support the work of the Hispanic Heritage Association of Southeastern PA and its volunteers that promote and bring awareness through events and partnerships including the *Hispanic Day of Celebration* to be celebrated here in the Borough of Conshohocken.
