AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15 *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC* OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN TO CREATE A ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PATTERN ON EAST SECOND AVENUE BETWEEN FAYETTE STREET AND HARRY STREET AND TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN 15 MINUTE “TO-GO ORDERS ONLY” PARKING SPACES ON EAST SECOND AVENUE AND EAST FIRST AVENUE AS MORE SPECIFICALLY SET FORTH HEREIN; REPEALING PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND CONTAINING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Borough Code to enact certain regulations relating to the public health, safety and welfare of the community of the Borough of Conshohocken;

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and the Borough Code to enact certain regulations concerning the movement of vehicles and traffic in and through the Borough;

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken has established, *inter alia*, regulations relating to vehicles and traffic within the Borough of Conshohocken at Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* of the Code of the Borough of Conshohocken;

WHEREAS, certain amendments to Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* have been recommended by the Borough’s administrative staff which amendments have previously been evaluated by the Borough using temporary experimental regulations prior to adopting this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken believes it to be in the best interest of the Boroughs to adopt the amendments to Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken as follows:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, Part 2 TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, § 15-207 *One-Way Streets Established* is hereby amended to include the following new one-way street:

Street	From	To	Direction of Travel
East Second Avenue	Fayette Street	Harry Street	East

SECTION 2.

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, Part 2 TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, § 15-213 *Stop Intersections Established* is hereby amended to include the following new stop intersection:

Stop Street	Intersection or Through Street	Direction of Travel
West Second Avenue	Forrest Street	East

SECTION 3.

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, Part 4 *GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS*, § 15-406 *Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited* is hereby amended by repealing the following specific purpose parking zone in its entirety:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Authorized Purpose or Vehicle</u>
East 1st Avenue	North	Between Fayette Street And Harry Street	15-minute "To-GO Orders Only parking (1 parking space identified by posted signage)

SECTION 4.

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, Part 4 *GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS*, § 15-406 *Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited* is hereby amended to include the following new special purpose parking areas:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Authorized Purpose or Vehicle</u>
East First Avenue	North	Between Fayette Street And Harry Street	15-minute "To-GO Orders Only" parking (3 parking spaces identified by posted signage)
East Second Avenue	North	Between Fayette Street and Harry Street	15-minute "To-Go Orders Only" parking (4 parking spaces identified by posted signage)

SECTION 5.

Any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in violation or in conflict with the terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such irreconcilable conflict.

SECTION 6.

The terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and, should any portion, part or provision of this ordinance be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, non-enforceable or unconstitutional, the Council hereby declares its intent that the ordinance shall have been enacted without regard to the invalid, non-enforceable, or unconstitutional portion, part or provision of this ordinance.

SECTION 7.

This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time permitted by Pennsylvania law.
