CALL TO ORDER

The Public Meeting of the Conshohocken Borough Council duly advertised, was held at the Conshohocken Borough Hall, 400 Fayette Street, Conshohocken, PA. Ms. Sokolowski, Borough Council President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

Ms. Sokolowski stated that Borough Administration did not receive any public comments following the March 4th public meeting or regarding the March 18th public meeting agenda.

Ms. Sokolowski announced that the St. Patrick's Day parade and Conshy Classic 5k were major successes. She thanked organizers and Borough staff for a well-run, safe event.

PUBLIC COMMENT (for agenda items only)

There were no public comments specific to agenda items.

PRESENTATIONS

a.) Proclamation 2026-03 designating April as "Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month"

Mr. Serna read a proclamation designating April as "Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month".

Ms. Kingsley made a motion to approve Proclamation 2026-03 designating April as "Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month", seconded by Mr. Frey. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

LAND USE MATTERS, PUBLIC HEARINGS AND ORDINANCES

There were no land use matters, public hearings and ordinances.

CONSENT AGENDA

Ms. Sokolowski read and reviewed the items included on the consent agenda.

**a.) Approve and adopt the February 4 and February 18 Regular Meeting Minutes
b.) Approve the February-ending Treasurer's Report and Accounts Payable**

Mr. Serna made a motion to approve and adopt the February 4 and February 18 Regular Meeting Minutes, seconded by Ms. Kingsley. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

Mr. Serna made a motion to approve the February-ending Treasurer's Report and Accounts Payable in the amount of \$992,942.50, seconded by Mr. Frey. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

a.) Consider awarding a bid for the Community Center Kitchen Renovation Project

Mr. Frey made a motion to award a bid for the Community Center Kitchen Renovation Project to Dellose Construction Services LLC in the amount of \$42,700, seconded by Ms. Kingsley. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

b.) Consider approving Resolution 2026-02 approving a supplemental appropriation for the purchase of the property located at 1105 Fayette Street (Parcel #05-00-03384-00-4)

Ms. Cecco explained that during the design of the new Public Safety Services Facility, Borough officials and consultants determined that acquiring the adjacent property would improve site access, traffic flow, drainage, and stormwater management.

Ms. Kingsley made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-02 approving a supplemental appropriation for the purchase of the property located at 1105 Fayette Street (Parcel #05-00-03384-00-4) in the amount of \$615,000 plus closing costs, seconded by Mr. Serna. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

NEW BUSINESS

- a.) **Consider approving promotions from the Civil Service Commission certified eligibility list for the positions of Lieutenant and Sergeant in the Police Department**

Chief Lennon provided an overview of the promotional civil service testing process.

Ms. Kingsley made a motion to approve the Civil Service certified eligibility list for the positions of Lieutenant and Sergeant and approve the promotions of Eric Hall to the position of Lieutenant and William Walter to the position of Sergeant, seconded by Mr. Frey. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

- b.) **Discuss the Civil Service Commission certified eligibility list for the position of patrol officer and consider approving a conditional offer of employment for the position of Patrol Officer**

Chief Lennon provided an overview of the patrol officer civil service testing process.

Ms. Kingsley made a motion to approve the Civil Service certified eligibility list for the position of patrol officer and approve the conditional offer of employment for Michael McGlenn for the position of patrol officer, seconded by Mr. Frey. The motion carried 4-0. (Bria, Chmielewski and Ellam absent)

COUNCIL AND MAYOR MATTERS

Mayor Aronson shared highlights from the St. Patrick's Day events, noting the parade's continued growth and thanking Borough staff for their efforts. He also highlighted a well-attended pre-parade run with the Conshohocken Running Club and reported on the fundraising results of the Philly Spin-In event.

Mr. Serna shared that the next event, Greenfest, will be held on Saturday, April 18th.
